

## Recent cases continued...

R v Bell [2019] (Teesside) Defending Vincent Bell who killed his brother Damian Banks by stabbing him through the heart during an argument. Acquitted of murder, convicted of manslaughter. Leading <u>Anthony Davis</u> of <u>Dere Street Barristers</u> and instructed by Richmond Anderson Goudie, Durham.

R v Grannon [2019] (Hull/Sheffield) Prosecuting Albert Grannon aged 78 who negligently shot and killed his 6 years old great grandson with an air rifle and pleaded guilty to gross negligence manslaughter. Instructed by CPS Complex Case Unit, Leeds.

R v Fletcher [2019] (Teesside) Defending Craig Fletcher who pleaded guilty to the murder of a guest in his home on Boxing Day 2018. The deceased was subjected to a prolonged assault carried out with Craig Barstow, part of which was recorded on a telephone recovered by the police. The sentencing judge categorised this as a sadistic murder when fixing a 25 year minimum term to be served. Leading <u>David Lamb</u> of Dere Street Barristers and instructed by BBNM Law, Redcar.
